Table has a primary key. However, MS Access prompts for the user to select columns for a unique record identifier. Whem the <a href="PostgreSQL">PostgreSQL</a> community driver psqlODBC is used to link the table, MS Access does not prompt for a unique identifier. It appears that the Mammoth ODBC driver is not returning the unique identifier information to MS Access.
