<p>Hi,</p> <p>I've been looking at Pitertools as there is a requirement here to have multiple log shipping slaves.</p> <p>While it seems to work well, a minor niggle is that cmd_standby.py steals the stdout stream from the (Debian) log files. I have worked around this by adding a 'I'm on Debian' parameter and using their start/stop scripts for instance start/stop if it is set. While this works, it is a mite heavy handed (starts/stops all instances of that version on the box)!</p> <p>Is there a better way that I've missed?</p> <p>Cheers</p> <p>Mark</p>
